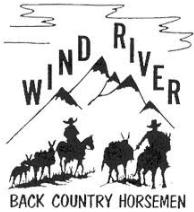


WYOMING BACK COUNTRY HORSEMEN STATE RENDEZVOUS

August 2nd-4th, 2024

Have your registration with liability release completed and returned by July 12th.



Come enjoy Blutcher Creek on the border of Fremont and Sublette County with your fellow Wyoming Back Country Horsemen, hosted by the Wind River Chapter. Blutcher Creek is a beautiful area just west of where our chapter clears 14 miles of the CDT every year from Pine Creek to Sweetwater Guard Station on the South Side of the Wind River Range. It's a mix of high desert country, mountains and trees, vistas and riding galore!

Events:

Friday Night: Dutch Oven Cobbler COOK OFF (Prize for the best cobbler) & Ice Cream - Pack Horse BINGO.

The Scavenger hunt begins at check in... you might get a golden ticket!

Saturday: Catered Dinner/Live Music/Silent Auction

We will have two guided trail rides starting Saturday morning, bring your fishing pole!

Sunday Morning: Breakfast-Biscuits & gravy, eggs and fruit, tear down and clean up.

HOW TO GET THERE:

Approximately 70 miles from Lander

From State Highway 28, turn north onto The Big Sandy Access Road/County Road 5-13/Continental Divide Road/Lander Cutoff and continue for 15 miles. Turn east onto BLM Road 4105/Sweetwater Gap Ranch Road for 3.3 miles, then take a left (west) on to BLM 4110/Blucher Creek Road for 4 miles.

Follow the signs!

Wyoming residents bringing horses need Brand Inspections. Out of state riders need Brand Inspections, Health Certificates, and current Coggins tests. ALL horses should be up to date and current with vaccinations.

Certified Weed Free Hay is required.

There will plenty of room to camp and high line your stock.

Horse owners are expected to remove all manure from your areas. Wheelbarrows and a container or dump trailer will be provided for manure disposal.

Water will be available for the horses, but no potable water is available on site. *Bring your own drinking water!*

Porta Potties will be available.

Dogs in camp must be leashed or contained. Dogs are not allowed on organized rides.

Please practice Leave No Trace and keep a tidy camp. This was a tough location to obtain!

The WYBCH Rendezvous follows a tradition of gathering together of outdoor horsemen enthusiasts!

WAIVER OF LIABILITY (All must sign and parents for minors)

I recognize the inherent risk attached to riding horses in the backcountry. I intend to be careful during the 2024 Wyoming Back Country Horsemen Rendezvous, and I willingly assume the risk of a possible accident or illness. I am also aware that Wyoming's Equine Liability Act severely restricts the right to recover for injuries or illnesses sustained in connection with riding horses.

In consideration for being allowed to attend and to participate in the 2024 Rendezvous, I hereby release Wyoming Back Country Horsemen ("WYBCH") and the Wind River Back Country Horsemen Chapter ("WRBCH") from liability for any and all claims concerning injuries incurred or illness contracted that might or could arise in connection with trail riding, food preparation, the campsite, the campfire, or any other facet of, or connected to, the 2024 Rendezvous.

This release of claims constitutes a waiver of liability not only with respect to the two corporations (WyBCH and WRBCH) but also, pursuant to the Wyoming Non-Profit Corporation Act, with respect to their officers, Boards of Directors, and other members; and I explicitly immunize the two corporations and their members from liability, even if the asserted injury or illness occurred as a result of negligence on their part. I further expressly acknowledge that my waiver applies not just to me personally but, additionally, to injuries or illnesses sustained by my minor children or by my stock or my pets.
